Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756–91) was an Austrian composer. Mozart composed music in several genres, including opera and symphony. His most famous compositions included the motet Exsultate, Jubilate, K 165 (1773), the operas *The Marriage of Figaro* (1786) and *Don Giovanni* (1787), and the *Jupiter Symphony* (1788). In all, Mozart composed more than 600 pieces of music.
